
27th International Sculptor's Symposium
Sur En, Sent GR (Switzerland)
5 June to 13 June 2021

REGULATIONS 2021
(ORIGINAL VERSION IN GERMAN)

1. Organizer

The symposium is organized by the association Art Engiadina Sur En / Sent. The steering committee (SC) consists of Wolfgang Bosshardt, Robert Schreyer, Daniel Cotti and Peter Horber. This committee will select the participants in the symposium. The event will be supported by several sponsors and donors. For further information please see 'www.art-engiadina.com'

2. Participants

The symposium will be open to individual artists and teams, in the following text known as „sculptors“. The term includes sculptor-teams, male and female sculptors.

3. Timetable 2021

15 March 2021	Application deadline (postage date). Description of idea, sketch or photograph of model, request for material (see form last page).
early April 2021	Selection of sculptors by Steering Committee.
16 April 2021	confirmation/rejection letters sent to sculptors by e-mail.

4. Process of the symposium

Saturday, 5 June 2021	Arrival of the participants, Setting up. Meeting point 6:00pm: Welcome, briefing for the symposium, followed by a dinner at the Camping Restaurant "Sper la Punt".
Sunday, 6 June to Saturday noon, 12 June 2021	Work period on the sculptures (camping area)

Saturday, 12 June 2021	from 3:00pm	Vernissage, public viewing of the finished sculptures at the workplaces
	from 4:30pm	Official Speeches, Announcement of the "Audience Award 2021"
	from 6:30pm	Public Closing Ceremony with Symposium party
Sunday, 13 June 2021		Placement of the artwork on the sculpture path in the forest. Clearing-up of workstations. Departure of participants.

5. Sculptures

For 2021, the Steering Committee has determined the theme «**Futur**» - the artists are free to interpret the theme and design their sculpture.

Each sculptor will receive a trunk of larch wood (green) about 4 meters long and 50 cm in diameter, or a block of marble (from Laas) with approximate dimensions of 50x40x100cm (it is possible to have a combination of larch wood and marble). It is also possible to use other material; however, these materials have to be organized and financed by the sculptors themselves and approved by the steering committee.

6. Selection Criteria

The submitted proposals/sketches/models will be selected on the following criteria:

- idea / originality
- style of interpretation
- practicability, use of material
- technical challenge
- overall impression

There will be no correspondence on the subject of projects and their selection or rejection. The Steering Committee decisions are final. Documents received will not be returned to sender.

7. Equipment / tools / workstations

Every sculptor will have access to 220-volt electricity. There will also be an air-compressor available.

All other tools will have to be organized by the sculptors themselves. The use of tools with combustion engines will be allowed. Each sculptor has to bring his/her own tent or motorhome for his/her accommodation for the week.

8. Time table for sculptors

- Working time Sunday to Friday 9:00am-7:00pm, Saturday 9:00am-1:00pm
- Breakfast 8:30am Restaurant Sper la Punt (Camping area)
- Lunch 12:30-1:30pm At the Saloon (Buffet)
- Dinner 8:00pm Alternate between Restaurant Sper la Punt
and Restaurant Val d'Uina

9. Services rendered by the organizers

- Each participant/team will be reimbursed by Art Engiadina with CHF 300 in cash for their expenses (per workplace). The winner of the 'Audience Award' receives an additional CHF 500.
- Free use of campsite and meals (without drinks) from Saturday 5 June 2021 evening to Sunday 13 June 2021 lunchtime
- Free working material (wood trunk (larch) or marble block)
- Free supporting program for artists

10. Insurance

Insurances in matters of accident / illness / tools etc. are the responsibility of the participating sculptors.

11. Accompanying persons / relatives

Accompanying persons can be taken along at their own expense. Meals / drinks of the accompanying persons in the restaurants are subject to a charge. Accompanying persons must be registered in advance in the restaurants.

12. Sculptures: Presentation, Sale, Placement

On Saturday 12 June 2021, the sculptures will be presented to the public. Visitors will then vote for the winner of the 'Audience Award'. On Sunday 13 June 2021, the new sculptures will be placed on the official 'Sculpture Path' (www.skulpturenweg-scuol.com). The sculpture must be left on the Sculpture Path for at least 2 years. If a

sculpture can be sold beforehand, it may be removed prematurely in consultation with the steering committee (SC). If sculptures are sold, the organizer (Art Engiadina) is entitled to a commission of 30% of the sales price. Sculptures that remain on the Sculpture Path for more than 5 years become the property of Art Engiadina.

Every sculptor grants the association Art Engiadina the right to film or photograph the sculptures for the promotion of the association and to use this film and photo material free of charge (no copyrights) for association purposes.
